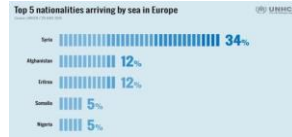

How does the violation of right effect life? The right to asylum.

The Universal Declaration of Human Rights

People seek asylum if one or more of their human rights are threatened e.g. freedom of speech, to be free from persecution or to have a home.



The countries that produce the most refugees in 2019

Syria	34%	People are fleeing because of the war happening in Syria.
Afghanistan	12%	People are fleeing because of wars or persecution.
Eritrea	12%	There is a dictatorship, the government is tightly controlled and people rights are being violated.
Somalia	5%	There was a civil war in Somalia.
Nigeria	5%	There is conflict inside the country where many people are being persecuted.

WOW words

Refugee	A person who has been forced to leave their country to escape persecution, war or disaster and have found a new home.
Asylum Seeker	A person who has been forced to leave their country to escape persecution, war or disaster who is seeking asylum in another country.
Refuge	A safe place or shelter
Corruption	Dishonest actions from someone in power.
Flee	To run away from danger
Rights	Things that humans are entitled to e.g. food, shelter, freedom of speech.
Civil War	A war between people in the same country
Dictator	A ruler with total power, typically obtained by force,
Bias	Unbalanced opinion for or against a particular group or race
Violation	When someones rights have been taken away by somebody in power.



Art- Sketching techniques- Shaun Tan



Shaun Tan is an artist who uses his art to demonstrate the experience pf travelling to a new country as a refugee, and how frightening it can be. He uses a range of sketching techniques in his book 'The Arrival'.

Stippling		Shading using small dots to create light and dark
Scumbling		Making circular scribbles to create depth
Shading		Creating a 3D effect by adding shadow
Smudging		Blending the pencil marks to create shades
Cross hatching		Drawing two layers of parallel lines to create shade or texture
