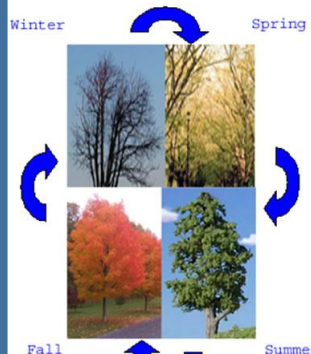

WOW words

deciduous

Trees that shed their leaves once a year.

evergreen

Trees that keep their leaves all year round.

leaves

Found on the stem of a plant. It absorbs light.

flowers

The seed bearing part of a plant.

petals

Brightly coloured part of a flower.

roots

Part of a plant that grows underground and sucks nutrients and water.

branches

Stems that grow from a tree trunk.

stem

The main stalk of a flower.

seed

Small parts of a flowering plant that can grow into a new plant.

bulb

A plant bud that begins to grow underground.

trunk

The stem of a tree.
