Dunce Hat	Slate	Cane	Abacus
			
A tall pointed hat with a letter 'D' or sometimes the word dunce written on it. It was worn by children who were slow at learning.	The hard slate material was generally set in a wooden frame. It was used for children to write on because paper was expensive.	Every teacher had a cane, with which to punish children. The cane was a stick of bamboo, rattan, or birch, usually about a metre long.	A counting frame used to help solve math calculations.
