Who is David Hockney?



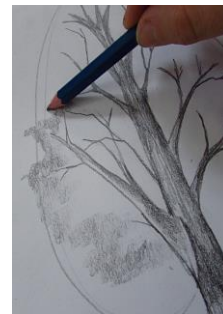
David Hockney is a British artist who is a painter, designer and photography. His recent paintings have included big scale paintings of trees through the four seasons.

To create sketches of trees by looking at the lines and shapes.

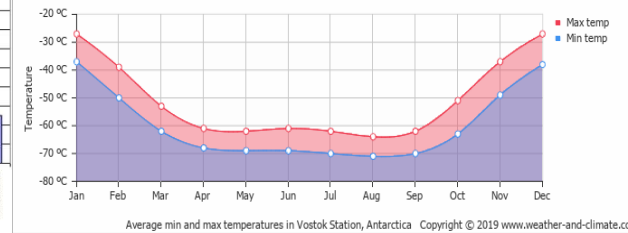
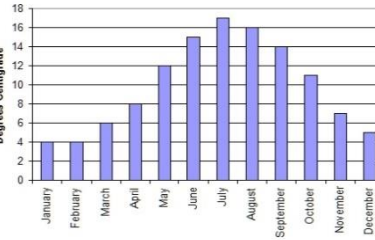


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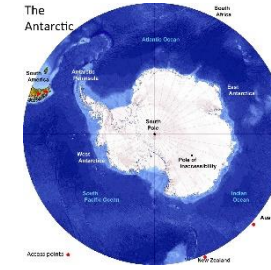

Physical features

Physical features are natural, they include beach, cliff, coast, forest, hill, mountain, sea, ocean, river, soil, valley, vegetation, season and weather.

Human features

Human features are man made they include city, town, village, factory, farm, house, office, port, harbour and shop.

Season

A season is a division of the year marked by changes in weather, ecology, and the amount of daylight.

Deciduous

A tree or shrub shedding its leaves annually.

Evergreen

A plant that retains its leaves through out the year.

Disforestation

The permanent removal of trees by cutting and clearing.
