Term	Focus/Theme	What School Parliament Will Do
1	Launch & Listening	Introduce new School Parliament members and their roles. Gather pupil voice on "Life at Lainesmead" and discuss ideas to improve school life. Represent the school within the local community.
2	Road Safety Week	Plan and lead Road Safety Week, including a pupil-led assembly and awareness campaign to promote safe walking and crossing.
3	Big Schools' Birdwatch	Work with Eco Warriors to take part in the Big Schools' Birdwatch. Make bird feeders, support class activities, and learn about local wildlife.
4	Children's Mental Health Week	Plan and lead activities based on the theme of belonging. This will include a pupil-led assembly, wellbeing activities, and opportunities for pupils to share their voices.
5	Walk to School Week	Work alongside Eco Warriors to promote active travel. Encourage pupils to walk, cycle, or scoot to school and take part in a whole-school challenge.
6	Reflection & Celebration	Reflect on the year's work, celebrate achievements, and share the impact of School Parliament with the school community.
