

Our Rights Y4 – How Have Our Rights Changed?



History: Victorian children's rights.

I know the historical chronological order of the following: Year 1, Year 2, Year 3, Victorians, 1840s, and the Vikings.

I use appropriate historical terms related to the Victorians (Appendix 2).

I can use a range of sources (photos/writing from the time/newspaper/books/videos/stories) to find out what life was like for children in the Victorian times.

I know the answer to the question: How did the rights of children change over the course of the Victorian era.

I can record in an organised and structured way using historical terms (appendix 2) what I have learnt about children's rights in the Victorian era.

I know how children's rights in the Victorian era compare to children's rights today.

Vocab

Era, time period, workhouse, schoolroom, orphan, orphanage, pauper, poverty.

Colours, smudging, lines, effect, shading, patterns, create, refine, materials, print, effect.

Art - William Morris printing designs

I know that the style of art and design changed over the Victorian period – look at Victorian artists and their different styles – colour and patterns.

I know that William Morris was a significant designer and that his style was different – vibrant colour.

I know William Morris' style was different by looking at his designs and talking about the features and techniques he used.

I know how to create my own block design by looking at examples of William Morris and how he created a repeating pattern.

I know that I can use different sketching techniques – shading to create the shapes and lines I need for my design – spiral/diagonal.

I know that if I evaluate as I design, I can improve my image.

I know how to create a pattern using the technique of block printing.

I know how to create a repeating pattern with a seamless print.

I know how to use more than one colour and more than one block on my design.

I know how to evaluate my print by comparing to William Morris' designs.



Computing: Research I know how to find answers to my questions using the internet

I know how to identify key words to search from a question I would to explore.

I know I know how to use search engine tools for different types of media e.g. Google Image Search, video, sound but understand that the results are not always what you expect

I know how to develop keywords and enter them into a chosen search engine. using more advanced search engine features.

I am aware that web sites are not always accurate and that information should be checked before it is used.

I know how to present my findings using a word processing or multimedia/publishing package for a specific audience.

I know I must put my findings in to my own words and not copy and paste from a website,

I know some search engines I can use to search for information.

I know how to skim read to find the answers to my questions.
