I know how to evaluate and select the materials I need with support.

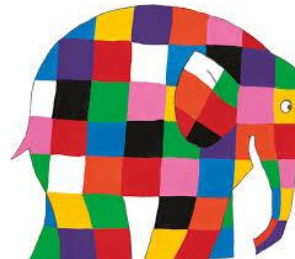
I know how to talk about my designs and choose the one which is the best.
