In maths the children will be learning to:

- Exploring pattern arrangements
- Make our own patterns
- Matching simple shapes
- Continuing to look at numbers 1-3
- Getting 2 or 3 items out of a group
- Look at dot patterns and arrange them

In Personal Social and Emotional Development the children will be:

- Taking turns with equipment
- Developing an awareness of others and their feelings
- Using kind hands
- Listening to others and responding appropriately
- Practicing breathing techniques to manage big feelings

In Literacy and Communication the children will be:

- Sharing stories
- Orally blending words e.g. p-i-g
- Making up actions to retell stories
- Talking about the characters in stories
- Recognising name and letters from our names
- Making marks linked to the story
- Asking questions and making links between texts we have looked at
- Using connecting words to extend sentences
- Learning new words and concepts in word aware
- Squiggling while we are wiggling



In Understanding of the world the children will be:

- Role-playing real-life experiences
- Looking at lifecycles
- Growing our own plants
- Talking about people who are important to us (Mother's Day)

In Physical Development the children will be:

- Developing pencil grip through funky fingers
- Using equipment safely
- Revisiting ball skills and climbing
- Talking about how to stay safe and make good choices
- Daily Dough Disco

In Expressive Art and Design the children will be:

- Using different materials to construct
- Copying rhythms and beats
- Continuing knowledge of rhyme singing rhyming soup
