That is not true!

Telling to HELP = BRAVE

Telling to help means:

- ✓ Someone is being hurt
- ✓ Someone feels scared
- ✓ Someone is unsafe
- ✓ You are worried about something

That is brave.



Telling to HURT = Unkind

Telling to hurt means

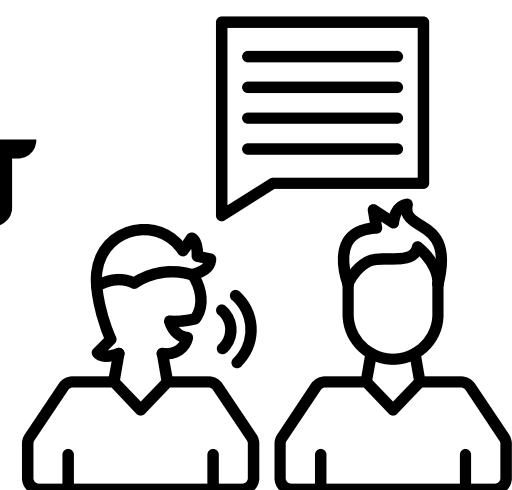
- ✗ Trying to get someone into trouble
- ✗ Saying something just to be mean
- ✗ Wanting revenge

That is not brave.
